Arrival / Departure

Begins at 10 am on Friday, Sept. 25th, but must be on grounds by 6:00 pm. Release at conclusion of show on Sunday, September 27th. All animals must be vet-checked prior to placing them into stalls.

Health Requirements

We recommend you contact New Mexico Livestock Board at (505)841-6161 to verify any regulations prior to departure. Also reference AOBA

Show Rules sections, "Registration and Health Requirements" later in this premium book.

1. **New Mexico Origin:** An Official Certificate of Veterinary Inspection issued within 30 days of the show for each animal transported to the show. This includes companion animals.
2. **Out of State Origin:** An Official Certificate of Veterinary Inspection issued within 30 days of the show for each animal transported to the show. This includes companion animals. All sexually intact animals (12 months of age and older) must have a negative test for Brucellosis within 30 days prior to entry. All animals (12 months of age and older) must have a negative test for TB within 30 days prior to entry.

NMSF Show rules

1. **Rules:** All rules governing livestock in General Rules and Regulations apply to this department.
2. **Stalls:** Stalls will be located in the Dairy Barn. **All alpaca and farm display stalls will be 6' x 12' with a dirt floor.** Exhibitor provides bedding or special floor coverings. Each animal must be in a rental stall (maximum 3 adults/yearlings or 4 juveniles). Tack stalls are 6' x 6'. Water hydrants and electrical outlets are located throughout the stalling areas. Washing and grooming areas for alpacas are located just outside the west exits. No vending is permitted from exhibitor's farm display areas.
3. **Feed:** All hays, supplements and water buckets to be provided by the exhibitors. The feedstore on grounds carries feed and bedding and can be reached at (505)934-2681.
4. **Security:** A night security guard is provided by NMSF and all gates are monitored when open. Exhibitors are encouraged to provide their own locking devices for tack stalls as well as place signage on each of their stalls with emergency contact information.
5. **Parking Facilities:** Special parking facilities will be provided for livestock trailers. Location to be announced. Parking passes will be mailed to you.

AOBA Show Rules

1. **Show Governance**

This show is governed by the rules of the Alpaca Owner's and Breeder's Association 2009 Show Division Handbook, Level II Show and the rules of the 2009 New Mexico State Fair. Actual show entries will be the final determination of the level of show. Applicable color groups and rules will apply.

2. **Registration and Health Requirements**

Alpacas must be registered by the ARI and be at least 6 months old at the time of show. A copy of the ARI certificate must accompany the entry form. No pending registration papers will be accepted. The date for determining the alpaca's age group is September 20th, 2009. Online registrations - Fax copies of your alpaca entry ARI certificates or ARI Registration Details to (575)683-0100. All alpacas entered in the show, companions or alpacas being transported and using the show venue as a stop off or transfer point must be identified with a microchip and must be examined by a veterinarian. Proof of a negative Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) or Viral Isolation (VI) test for Bovine Viral Diarrhea Virus (BVDV), must be provided for each alpaca before they will be permitted entrance to the NMSF Dairy Barn. A negative PCR or VI test is good for the life of the alpaca insuring that it is not a Persistently Infected (PI) animal. The negative test must be stated on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (Health Papers). (See section 9 item C on page 8-31 of the 2009 AOBA Show Rules. **The owner shall submit a copy of the health papers, which shall include the alpacas ARI name, ARI number and microchip ID# and proof of a negative PCR or VI test for BVDV for each alpaca entering the AOBA Certified Show venue, to the show superintendent. The show superintendent shall maintain the copy of the health papers as part of the permanent records of the show. Health papers dated within 30 days of the show are required for all alpacas entering the venue of an AOBA Certified Show. It is requested that a copy of the PCR or VI test results from the lab or the veterinarian be attached to the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection.**

3. **Entries**

Must be made in the name of the registered owner as listed on the ARI certificate, or the ARI Contract Buyer certificate if entered alpaca is sold, but not yet transferred. An AOBA Owner of Record for Show Entry Form.

4. **Number of Entries**

The owner may enter only three alpacas per breed type per gender per age division per color designation.

5. **Fleece Length**

Please notify the superintendent if there is a change in status of entry's fleece length. Fleece length will be checked upon check-in and is determined by AOBA show rules.

6. **Color Check**

Will be done at check-in and use appropriate ARI color charts. **If your entry has changed fleece color since issue of the ARI certificate, please put the actual fleece color class of your alpaca on the entry form.**

7. **Shorn Color Classes**

If there are enough entries (4) per sex, age and color group, then separate color group classes will be held in Shorn according to Level I/II color groups. If not, they will be combined into classes based on breed, gender and age.

8. **Group Classes**

All alpacas entered in the Group classes must be eligible and entered to show in their respective Halter class.

1st through 6th place will receive Rosettes. Rosettes will also be presented for Color and Reserve Color Championships.

2009 Mandatory Exhibitor Disclosure

Under the Show System Handbook Rules, certain alpacas and fleeces are automatically disqualified from competition and certain Exhibitors & Handlers are prohibited from personally showing in front of a Judge when a business or financial relationship exists between an AOBA Certified Judge and their customers.

Each year at contract renewal time, our Judges are required to disclose those alpacas, exhibitors and handlers who cannot be shown in their show ring when judging at an AOBA Certified show. Exhibitors are also required to disclose business and financial relationships with Judges and to acknowledge animals/fleece entered into the competitions that are not allowed to show in front of certain Judges at each show they attend. This is being done to ensure Exhibitors understand the written rules and to eliminate confusion for Exhibitors & Handlers about which alpacas, Exhibitors & Handlers cannot walk into a Judge's show ring during competition and which fleeces can not be entered into a Fleece Show.

Using your 2009 AOBA Show System Handbook that is posted to the AOBA Show System website, please see Part 5. Rules & Ethics for All Show Participants; Section 2, Rules for Exhibitors and Handlers, S. An alpaca/fleece is disqualified from competition if..... T. An Exhibitor or Handler, including his/her immediate family.... And U. An Exhibitor is prohibited from entering an alpaca's fleece if
