Special Rules

1. All entries in this department are subject to the General Rules and Regulations.
2. This department will be open to receive fleeces Thursday, September 10, 2009 from 9:00 am – 5:00 pm in the Dairy Barn show ring. If fleeces are shipped, carrying charges must be prepaid and exhibits must arrive no later than Wednesday, September 9, 2009.
3. Fleeces will be released on Sunday, September 20th. Exhibitors must make arrangements to pick up fleeces.
4. Each exhibitor will be limited to two premiums in each class.
5. Each fleece must have been shorn in the current season and not represent more than 12 months growth (14 for lamb fleeces).
6. Fleeces may be exhibited in clear plastic bags (tied or untied).
7. Points of disqualification:
 - a. Improperly prepared for show
 - b. Contamination with sisal or polypropylene fibers
 - c. Inclusion of parts of another fleece.
8. Categories
 - a. White handspinning wool
 - b. Natural Colored Wool – Solid (consistent color throughout the fleece)
 - c. Natural Colored Wool – Variegated (different colors or shades in different parts of the fleece)
9. Each Category will be divided into the following classes
 - a. Fine wool grading 60's or finer
 - b. Medium wool grading 50's to 58's
 - c. Longwool breed fleeces grading 38's to 48's
 - d. Hair or Fur Breed fleeces
